The **Families in Transition (FIT)** program supports those eligible under the McKinney-Vento Act.

- · Utilizing hotels, motels, or transitional shelters?
- Needing assistance with voucher programs (NEMCSA/DHHS)?

- Then You May Be Eligible For FIT Program Support!

Services Offered by FIT Program

- · Immediate school enrollment
- · Coordination of educational and social services
- Provision of essential school supplies and clothing
- Assistance with educational and transportation challenges
- Referral assistance for younger siblings for potential Early Childhood Programs
